

**Travelwide Reisen**  
**Guyana Birding Tour**  
**October 18 to October 30, 2006**  
**12 Nights/13 Days**

**OCTOBER 2006**

- Wed 18      Arrive in Guyana and transfer to Georgetown. Overnight at Cara Lodge.
- Thu 19      0900 depart by road to Prairie International Hotel on the East Bank Demerara. Boat trip on the Demerara, Kamuni and Pokerero Rivers to Timberhead Rain Forest Resort, where lunch will be served. Birding along Jaguar/Agouti Trail and then pickup by boat and back to resort via Pokero Creek. Overnight at Timberhead Rain Forest Resort. BLD
- Fri 20      Early morning birdwalk. After breakfast canoe to trailhead and then walk through forest to Santa Mission. Return by boat for lunch. Boat ride along creeks to Arrow Point and beyond. Night boating in search of caiman and water lilies. Overnight at Timberhead Rain Forest Resort. BLD
- Sat 21      After breakfast, transfer by boat to Sand Hills on the Demerara River. Continue by jeep through the rainforest to Shanklands Rainforest Resort. Afternoon walk to see vegetation and bird-life. Overnight at Shanklands Rainforest Resort. BLD
- Sun 22      Before breakfast, walk on the trails of the resort looking for birdlife. Morning boat tour to Marshall Falls, Kyk-Over-Al and Bartica. Afternoon: Depending on weather conditions and time: boat ride on Essequibo River along Mazaruni shipwreck into side-creeks to oxbow lake or walk around Shanklands for bird and wildlife watching. Overnight at Shanklands Rainforest Resort. BLD
- Mon 23      After breakfast, transfer by boat on the Essequibo River to Baganara Island. Flight to Kaieteur Falls by charter, total of two hours minimum at the Falls. Continue flight to private airfield at Karanambu Ranch in time for late lunch. Afternoon boat trip on the Rupununi River. Dinner at main house. Overnight at Karanambu Ranch. BLD
- Tue 24      Walk before breakfast to see the bird and animal life. After breakfast boat trip on the Rupununi River to Crane Pond. Afternoon drive through Savannah to Outer Station to see termite mounds, great views and birds. Overnight at Karanambu Ranch. BLD

- Wed 25 After breakfast, boat trip along the Rupununi River to Ginep Landing. Transfer by 4x4 to Rock View Lodge at Annai. Afternoon walk through area to see birds and vegetation. Overnight at Rock View Lodge. BLD
- Thu 26 After breakfast, half day walk to Boulder Ridge. Return to Rock View Lodge for lunch. Afternoon at leisure or visit of area and local market. Overnight at Rock View Lodge. BLD
- Fri 27 After breakfast drive to Iwokrama Rainforest and visit the Iwokrama Canopy Walkway. Experience the canopy from the vantage of 35 metres up in the tree-tops. Continue on to the Iwokrama Field Station with bird and wildlife watching along the way. Visit the Canopy walkway and the Cock-of-the-rock Trail. In the afternoon explore the trails around the field station with an Iwokrama Ranger. After dinner, we will take you out on to the river to spot caiman and other nocturnal wildlife. Overnight at the Iwokrama Rainforest Field Station. BLD
- Sat 28 This morning take a boat ride north along the Essequibo River for bird and wildlife watching. Return to the field station for lunch. In the afternoon/early evening take a boat trip south on the Essequibo including a visit to Kurupukari Falls to see the Amerindian petroglyphs (dependent on the water level). Then visit the small Amerindian village of Fair View before returning to the Field Station. Overnight at the Iwokrama Rainforest Field Station. BLD
- Sun 29 Before breakfast wildlife walk with an Iwokrama Ranger close to the Field Station. After breakfast pick-up and drive north with bird and wildlife watching to Mabura Hill, Linden and Georgetown. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at Cara Lodge. BLD
- Mon 30 After breakfast city tour of Georgetown. If time allows in the afternoon visit to Double B Exotic Gardens. Transfer to airport for departing flight. BL
